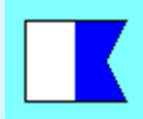
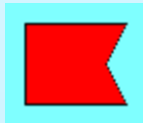


### Meanings of International Maritime Signal Flags

International Maritime Signal Flags are used to signal between two ships or between ship and shore. They can be used to spell out messages, or used singly or in combinations to convey special messages.



A –diver below (when stationary) or undergoing a speed trial



B – dangerous goods



C – affirmative (yes)



D - keep clear, manoeuvring with difficulty



E - altering my course to starboard



F - disabled, communicate with me



G - require a pilot



H - pilot on board
