

Unit project

After learning this unit, you are going to accomplish a project with other members in a group.

Background:

The Port of Singapore is the busiest container transshipment hub in the world. Located on the southern end of the Malay Peninsula, 30km south-west of the Port of Johor in Malaysia, the Port of Singapore offers connectivity to more than 600 ports in 123 countries. It is the largest publicly owned port in the world.

Suppose M/V YUKUN is approaching the Port of Singapore, and discuss with your group members the procedures of pilotage. The detailed requirements are listed below.



1. Work in groups of three.
2. Role-play the master, the third officer, and the pilot respectively. Your conversations shall include:
 - Calling the port operation through VHF communication;
 - Reporting the ship's name, her call sign, and the ship's particulars;
 - Requiring a pilot to board the ship and asking for the pilot's boarding information including boarding time, ladder, etc.;
 - Working with a pilot on the ship.
3. Present in front of the whole class.
